

## Curriculum vitae of **Eberhard Schlicker**

Eberhard Schlicker was born in 1952 in Stuttgart and studied medicine from 1972 to 1979 at the Universities of Freiburg and Heidelberg. After completion of his internship in Bad Merzheim he received the licence to practice as a physician (1979) and received his MD degree (Doctor medicinae) from the University of Heidelberg (1979). In 1979 he worked as a postdoctoral fellow with V.A.W. Kreye at the Institute of Physiology of the University of Heidelberg. From 1980 to 1986 he worked as a postdoctoral fellow with M. Göthert at the Pharmacological Institute of the University of Duisburg-Essen. In 1984 he received the degree of a physician specialized for pharmacology and toxicology. Since 1986 he has been working at the Institute of Pharmacology and Toxicology of the University of Bonn where he completed his habilitation thesis in 1986. He held the rank of a lecturer (1986-1987) and was assistant professor (1987-1992, "C2-Professur") and in 1992 received a tenured position ("außerplanmäßiger Professor"). E. Schlicker has published 147 articles (according to the PubMed database). His scientific research has been being supported by the German Research Foundation (Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft, DFG) since 1988. So he received Individual Grants and was member of a Collaborative Research Centre (Sonderforschungsbereich) and a Research Training Group (Graduiertenkolleg); currently, he is member of the Research Unit "Forschergruppe 926". He received the Rottendorf Prize (1993) and the Copernicus Award (2006; from the DFG) and is ISI Highly Cited Researcher in the field of pharmacology (Thomson Reuters). He serves as an editor for the journal "Naunyn-Schmiedeberg's Archives of Pharmacology".
